In the book *Trust No One* by award-winning author Gregg Hurwitz, lovers of a good thriller find an action packed story full of suspense and a guaranteed adrenaline rush.

Together with the main character, Nick Horrigan, the reader is pushed into a web of betrayal, conspiracy, manipulation, and national security issues. Nick must keep moving to stay alive while trying to understand how the death of his father during his adolescent years lies at the roots of his current ordeals.

The book begins when Nick is suddenly ripped out of his sleep by a SWAT team raid on his apartment. He is apprehended and taken to a waiting helicopter that will bring him to a nuclear reactor where a terrorist is threatening to cause massive devastation unless his demand is met – an encounter with Nick at the site. During the helicopter ride Nick is interrogated about a relationship with the terrorist and implicitly accused of being an accomplice. To prove his innocence, he must cooperate with the Secret Service to prevent a major catastrophe.

This night marks the beginning of a new life for Nick. Loyalties will be tested. Having tapped into a conspiracy, relationships and communication with family and friends change dramatically. Nick must disentangle a web of events that happened years ago involving his father's murder and react quickly to a series of threatening events in order to protect his life and his loved ones. As Nick continues to dig deeper, and tries to find, capture, defeat and unmask those who killed his father and are trying to keep him quiet, he realizes that he can *Trust No One*. He will depend on his basic survival instincts to outsmart them.

Trust No One is well-researched and the plot incorporates many issues from past political news reports.

Apart from the story itself, the skillful, sophisticated and elegant use of the English language makes for delightful reading. The book is full of eloquent narrative, superb dialogs, vivid scenes, and unexpected twists that will capture the reader's attention from beginning to gripping end. I foresee this book becoming a major Hollywood film.

I highly recommend this thriller to any reader seeking a page-turner about political deceit and cover-up, and who loves a brilliantly written, fast paced story.
